

There aren't many artistic mediums that have a bad reputation, but spray paint definitely makes the list.

There aren't many artistic mediums that have a bad reputation, but spray paint definitely makes the list. Despite historically being associated with vandalism, it's gained contemporary respect and the medium is favored among street artists and muralists. It's early artistic applications started in the late 50's and 60's in black and latino neighborhoods around New York City.

One of the first well known graffiti artists was Darryl McCray, known as Cornbread, who at age 17,

jumped a fence at the Philadelphia Zoo and spray painted "Cornbread Lives" on the side of an elephant. Most

to tag train cars and subway tunnels, appreciating their large works in motion. Eventually spray paint evolved beyond just text based calligraphic works to involve more imagery and take up full walls. Key artists in this shift included Keith Haring and Jean-Michel Basquiat. As the artwork evolved, so

graffiti artists at the time preferred

did the medium! Artists began using stencils and a variety of paint nozzles to achieve unique effects. Some brands began to specialize by making paints designed to last longer, with good consistency and spray dispersion. Many of those brands are still favored by street artists today, like the Montana Spray paints we carry at The Blok DSM. 🗳



Do you know what engagement photos, girl scouts, veganism, and uplifting your community common? Keesha Ward knows. Introducing a mover and shaker who is mpowering her community and making sure they ook damn fine while she does it. Whether she's behind the camera or in front of a crowd, Keesha is a pro at making things happen.

Not only is she a professional photographer, the owner of her own plant-based living brand, she's also the COO of Girl Scouts of America. Keesha ties these passions together with a dedication to supporting the black community.

She's organized a number of photoshoots aimed at showcasing black love, black entrepreneurs, and black youth. Her work with the girl scouts is similarly focused, as Keesha explains she's "encouraging girls to empower themselves". Her plant-based living brand Vegan-Knees has even hosted coaching sessions aimed at opening conversation around cultural foods and how black individuals can improve their health.




